

# Student Uniform, Appearance, and Hygiene Policy

## Rationale

The School values proper student dress, appearance, and cleanliness. Uniforms promote the School community and appearance is a form of respect. Cleanliness is important for health.

## Student Uniform and Dress

### Shoes and Socks General

- Black, white or black and white shoes
  - Formal or sport shoes, but should not be made of canvas or be chequered (e.g. Vans, Converse)
  - Acceptable 'sports' shoes would be varieties of Nike, Adidas, etc. where the black/white colouring is kept to a stripe or logo. Please see the website for examples of acceptable designs.
- Socks – black or white

### School Uniform General

- Hat
  - The hat may only be worn by students during break time and in outdoor PE lessons.
- Polo shirt, long and short sleeved
- PE t-shirt, long and short sleeved
- PE trousers, Long and short
- Formal trousers or shorts
- Formal Skorts (optional for girls)
- PE hoodie
- Jacket

Parents and students are free to choose their combination of shirt and trousers/skirt to suit their needs.

If uniforms or certain sizes are not available, students may temporarily wear black clothing in place of uniform items. Once the items are in stock, they must be worn.

The Student Behaviour Management Policy will be applied to any students not wearing the correct uniform. Please note that all uniform items provided by the school store must be purchased from the school only. Any student unable to wear the correct uniform for a temporary reason should have their parents contact the School's administration.

## Appearance

Students are required to:

- Have acceptable hairstyles with no extreme hair colours and long hair must be tied back
- Nose, brow, septum, tongue, lip, and any other facial piercings except ears are forbidden
- Nail varnish, polish, or gel, and make-up is forbidden

### **Hygiene**

Students are expected to be clean and not have body odour.
